#### Calculation Notes

The number of delayed days of care for the period Nov 16 to Jan 17 attributable to social were obtained from <https://www.england.nhs.uk/statistics/statistical-work-areas/delayed-transfers-of-care/2016-17-data/>

The number of days was then annualised, to give a yearly estimate for each authority.

The 17/18 allocation has then been divided by this annual number of days, to give a spend per delayed day of care attributable to social care.

\* Local authority is authority with one of the highest 24 DTOC rates.
