What especially impressed the judges was the approach the council took to really understand what citizens needed in order to deliver its new Empower Card. As a result the council worked with a card issuer to deliver a more flexible solution which included emergency payments. The team has also tackled barriers around its use so it has been developed for personal health budgets, children's services and benefits and leisure.
